

On Monday, April 3, 2017, the names of the four finalists for the position of Superintendent of Florence City Schools were presented to the school board in a called meeting by Dr. Terry Jenkins, a consultant with the Alabama Association of School Boards, who led the superintendent search. The four candidates were chosen from a pool of 25 applicants for the position. The candidates listed alphabetically are:

Dr. Catherine Beck-Assistant Superintendent of Summit School District in Breckenridge, Colorado, and a former Florence resident.

Dr. Boyd K. English-Superintendent of Crenshaw County Board of Education.

Dr. Alan Miller-Superintendent of the Haleyville Board of Education.

Dr. Jimmy Shaw, Jr.-Assistant Superintendent of Instruction, Florence City Schools.

The interview process will begin next week, with one candidate per day scheduled. A portion of each interview will be open to the public.
